Participants	<ul> <li>A. Cities with an Adult league participation of less than 250 players</li> <li>B. Players who have not had the opportunity to play at their specific NTRP level locally</li> <li>C. Teams from cities that could not fill 3 teams in the 3.5 or 4.0 level. <ul> <li>a. At least 2 teams must enter the qualifying tournament in a particular level to be able to offer that level.</li> <li>b. A city may only send one team unless a wild card is offered (if 2 teams, a winner must be determined locally)</li> <li>c. The USTA Texas Championship Committee has discretion as to who is eligible.</li> <li>d. Must reside outside of the 50 mile radius of the city with leagues at your specific level.</li> <li>e. Entries Due	June 1, 2024
Format	All teams will compete in round robin format, playing each team in their respective NTRP division. All levels will field 3 individual doubles and 2 singles for a team match except in the 2.5 and 5.0 level. The 2.5 and 5.0 level will field 2 individual doubles and 1 singles for a team match.
Scoring	All team matches will be regular scoring for the first 2 sets with a 12 point tie break at 6 all. If a match should go to a 3rd set, a match tiebreak (first to 10, winning by 2) will be played in lieu of a 3rd set. The 3rd set tiebreak will count as 1 set and 1 game for scoring purposes. The tournament referee may need to modify further if rain or other extenuating circumstances should occur. If the number of teams dictate, a shortened format may be used.
Team Points	The team with the most points will be declared the winner in each NTRP category with any team tie being handled as outlined in the National regulation handbook. One point will be given when a team wins the majority of individual matches. The winning team in each NTRP level will be invited to advance to the Texas USTA Adult 18 & Over League Sectional Championship.

If a match should go to a 3rd set, a match tiebreak (first to 10, winning by 2) will be played in lieu of a 3rd set. The 3rd set tiebreak will count as 1 set and 1 game for scoring purposes. The tournament referee may need to modify further if rain or other extenuating circumstances should occur. If the number of teams dictate, a shortened format may be used.
Team Points	The team with the most points will be declared the winner in each NTRP category with any team tie being handled as outlined in the National regulation handbook. One team point will be given when a team wins the majority of individual matches. The winning team in each NTRP level will be invited to advance to the Texas USTA Adult 40 & Over League Sectional Championship.

No more than 1.0 NTRP rating difference between individual doubles teams. Teams can advance directly to sectionals without playing a local league. If you have a local league, players must play at least one match locally to advance to Sectionals.

If you have any 9.5, 5.5 ladies, and 6.5 mens local league confirm with the section that there are other cities to play against at sectionals since this level does not always make. No more than 1.0 NTRP rating difference between individual doubles teams. Combo goes by year-end ratings. Combo does not factor into your rating. Teams can go directly to Sectionals without playing in a local league. If there is a local league, players must play at least one match locally to advance to Sectionals.
